CREDENTIALING

Entry Fees:

1x individual challenge per cheerleader- \$30.00

1x crossover fee per cheerleader- \$30.00 (MUST PAY IF ENTERED IN MORE THAN ONE DIVISION)

Competition entry fees must be paid on or before 26 August 2011. Entries paid after this date will incur a \$10.00 late fee.

Cheerleader of the Year:

Minimum Routine Requirements: 3 Jumps, 1 Tumbling Pass, Cheer, Motions, Dance

Length of Routine: 1 Minute (deductions will be incurred if over time) **Level:** Up to & incl Level 5

Duo of the Year:

Minimum Routine Requirements: 3 Jumps, 1 Tumbling Pass, Cheer, Motions, Dance, Partner Work/Synchronization

Length of Routine: 1 Minute (deductions will be incurred if over time) **Level:** Up to & incl Level 5

The focus for duo & cheer routines should be on motion technique, vocal projection, dance, jumps and tumbling. The routine should include a variety of movement levels, direction and rhythm. The routine should include a cheer section. The routine must demonstrate creative/original choreography.

Dancer of the Year

Minimum Routine Requirements: The focus on the routine should be on dance technique and skills. The routine should demonstrate creative/original choreography. Judging criteria will be based on communication, execution, choreography & technique. Please note the following tumbling skills are not allowed in dance routines under the USASF rules: Front tucks, back tucks, roundoff series back handsprings, shushunovas, headsprings without hand support, dive rolls in a layout position, layouts, side somi. Please also note that front and back handsprings are permitted as a hip hop trick ONLY.

Length of Routine: 1 Minute (deductions will be incurred if over time)

Stunt Team/Partner Stunt

Details: Perform as many stunts as you can in 1 minute. Judging criteria will be based on difficulty, execution, choreography & technique. Entire routine must be performed to music.

Length of Routine: 1 Minute (deductions will be incurred if over time)

Level: All skills up to and including Level 5
